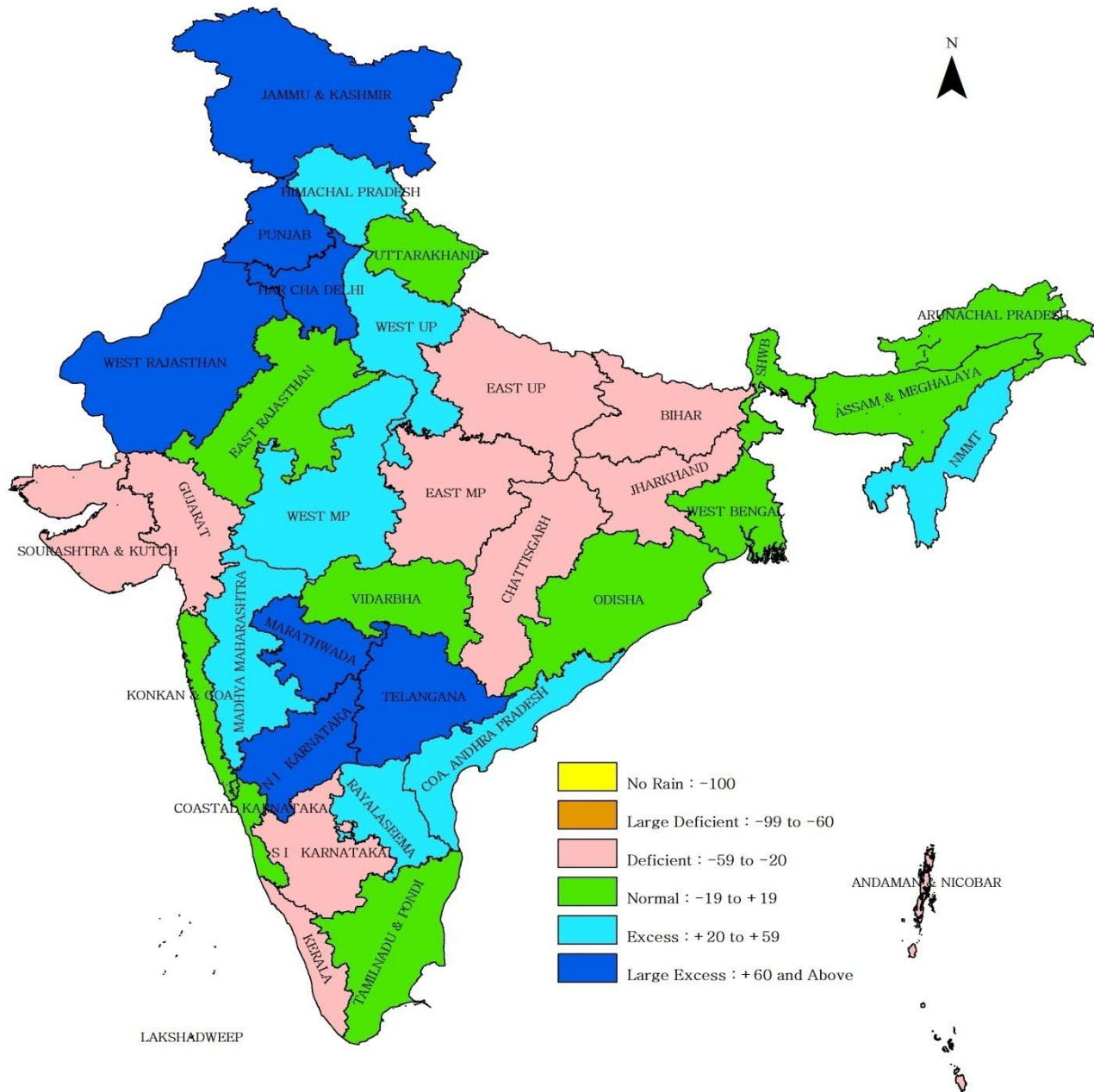

1. Coastal Karnataka, Kerala, Odisha, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Northeastern states received good amount of rainfall yesterday.
2. Favorable conditions are developing for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of Vidarbha; remaining parts of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand & Bihar and some parts of East Madhya Pradesh & East Uttar Pradesh during the next 48 hours.
